Since 2007 I have been teaching and conducting research as Professor for Computational Design, covering the Bachelor, Master and post-graduate study programs at the School of Architecture and Interior Design, Hochschule Ostwestfalen-Lippe, University of Applied Sciences in Detmold, Germany.

My academic and practical work is reflected and complemented in numerous international publications, lectureships and paper presentations as well as guest critics, peer reviews and scientific reports.
