Dear Students and Colleagues,

the new Decree of the President Council of March 11 asks us to guarantee the public service (in our case the right to study) and at the same time to reduce mobility in order to contain the contagion. This translates into a series of indications, that can be summarized as follows:

- provide teaching, exams and graduations in distance mode without interrupting the current semester;
- providing all services of the University, using smart working;
- define the minimum essential services that need to be provided in presence, and cannot be deferred.

The monitoring unit, which met today, has therefore defined a series of actions to respond to the decree. We confirm the delivery of all lessons from Monday, March 16.

From next Monday in fact the last studios of the School of Architecture, Urban Planning, Construction, Engineering and the School of Design will start in distance mode. This new form of teaching involves increasing our ability to manage group work in distance mode. However, we invite students and Professors to exploit the potential of the Teams platform to work independently and individually, from their own workplace, avoiding meeting in presence to perform the group work. The same recommendation is also extended to the team of Professors and Tutors.

Tomorrow the lessons will take place as planned. Naturally, we invite Professors, where possible, to give lessons from their residences.

We confirm, however, the presence of the equipped classrooms for those who had requested it; the monitoring unit is preparing a plan to optimize the use of the classrooms starting next week, in response to these new provisions.

We have also defined with the Departments, the Campuses and the Divisions of the University the essential services for which a minimal presence in the University is required: for instance the ICT support for the management of the network, the servers and the connections, services for students with disabilities, DSU (right to study), exchange programs, the structures responsible for cleaning and sanitation, security, access, maintenance and work that cannot be postponed. All other services will be guaranteed by smart working.

Moreover the new dispositions confirms the impossibility to carry out all the planned Tests on line until April 3.

Given the difficulties reported by many students, it was decided to extend to April 30 the presentation of ISEE and ISEEU.

I invite all colleagues to avoid transfers to any university premises except for essential services that cannot be provided at a distance. To you students, I ask to avoid all transfers to the university and also the stay in the spaces of the university.
