Dear Students and Colleagues,

the monitoring unit met today to define the new arrangements of the University following the directions of the DPCM of March 11. After consultation with the Departments, Divisions and Regional Campuses, it was decided to limit entrances to the campuses, but to guarantee teaching, exams and graduations in distance mode, without interrupting the regular progress of the semester.

In particular:

- Departments will be accessible through personal badges from 8 to 20.
- study areas and classrooms on campuses will not be accessible.
- the services of the central administration and the departments will be guaranteed through smart working where possible.
- the following services will be delivered in presence: management of emergency functions; teaching support activities and related services to students and Professors; experimental activities that cannot be postponed; ICT services support for remote learning and for the administration activities; safety and access services; minimum logistic and reception services; mail and protocol services; cleaning and sanitation services; maintenance and supply services related to the emergency; work supervision activities at active building sites; minimum services for works that cannot be postponed;
- the access to laboratories will be allowed for those involved in research to face the ongoing crisis and, only exceptionally and occasionally, for activities that cannot be postponed or to support thesis work;
- in Leonardo Campus, Building 3, some classrooms will be opened for Professors who confirmed the need of support for their lessons and a support service will be present. The assignment of classrooms will be indicated directly in the personal time schedule starting from tomorrow for Professors who confirmed the need.
- in Regional Campuses a support service for remote learning will be present.

The University started a careful monitoring of Erasmus exchange students, ensuring that they are included in distance learning in case of return.

Once again, I invite all colleagues, however, to avoid transfers to any university premises except for essential services that cannot be provided at a distance.
