Starting from May 30 the TOLD (Design Tests) will also take place with the same modalities.

TOLs dedicated to students who are currently attending the fourth year of high school will be organized from September.

I thank all those who have engaged in this complicated organization by finding appropriate technical solutions, testing the method, monitoring the results, assisting the students.
