**IN VIEW** of the agreement that Politecnico di Milano intends to enter into with CISIA for the remote administration of the test;

**HAVING ACKNOWLEDGED** the requirement to publish the call for applications for admission relating to the procedures for administration of the tests for admission to the degree courses aimed at architectural training, in accordance with directive 2005/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 7/9/2005;

**PENDING** the approval of the Academic Senate;

## **DECREES**

### **ART. 1 - Courses and available spaces**

The total number of spaces available for enrolment is separated into:

- Spaces for **EU and equivalent** students as per Legislative Decree of 25.7.98, no. 286, art. 39, paragraph 5, modified by art. 26 of Italian Law of 30.7.2002, no. 189, hereinafter “EU and equivalent students”;
- Spaces for **non-EU** students who do not fall under the provisions of art. 39, paragraph 5, of Legislative Decree 25.7.98, no. 286, modified by art. 26 of Italian Law of 30.7.2002, no. 189; hereinafter “non-EU students”.

**ART. 2 - Access to the courses**

The admission of applicants to the programmes referred to in art. 1 takes place by way of completion of the admission test, which will **only** take place on **28 July 2021**.

Applicants who have already completed secondary school or who are in their final year of secondary school may register for the test.

**ART. 3 - How to register for the test**

**Registration will open at 10:00am (GMT+1) on 4 June 2021 and close at 2:00pm (GMT+1) on 20 July 2021.**

After registering on the Politecnico website [www.polimi.it/servizionline](http://www.polimi.it/servizionline), it will be possible to register for the test from the Online Services [www.polimi.it/servizionline](http://www.polimi.it/servizionline) and in particular:

- “Lauree triennali e a ciclo unico: test di ingresso o di recupero ed immatricolazione > Iscrizione al test > Test di Architettura” [“Laurea and single-cycle degrees: entry or catch-up tests and enrolment > Registration for tests > Architecture Test”];
- after paying the test registration fee, choose the test language (Italian or English) and indicate the programmes you are interested in enrolling in, expressing a minimum of one and a maximum of six preferences; these preferences can be changed until 2:00pm (GMT+1) on 20 July 2021. The indication of your preferences will be binding for the purposes of producing the first ranking, as per art. 7 et seq.

It is noted that payment alone does not complete the registration; the full process must be concluded, obtaining the test registration receipt. At the end of the registration process, the system will issue a "registration receipt" specifying the day and time of the test.

#### **ART. 4 - How the test is administered remotely**

The admission test will be administered remotely according to the procedures detailed on the CISIA website: [www.cisiaonline.it](http://www.cisiaonline.it).

The university will not allow the test to be taken in any other way.

#### **ART. 5 - Contents of the admission test and scoring**

The procedure and contents of the test, as well as the scoring, are regulated by Ministerial Decree no.624 of 27 May 2021 and its annexes, available on the website: [www.miur.gov.it](http://www.miur.gov.it).

#### **ART. 6 - Applicants with disabilities and specific learning disabilities**

Applicants with disabilities can indicate their situation in advance when registering for the test, so that the Politecnico Multi Chance Poli Team service can contact them to verify the clinical or disability certificates that they possess, to check their specific requirements and to agree upon how the test indicated in this Call can be administered, in accordance with Italian Law 104/1992, as amended.

The Politecnico Multi Chance Poli Team will:

- contact them to check the suitability of the SLD certificate which must be issued, no more than 3 years before, by the National Health Authorities or by specialists and facilities accredited by the same, on the model of the Consensus Conference, attaching the tests carried out and the scores achieved during the last assessment, in conformity with the note

of the Lombardy Regional Government dated 05/07/2011 on SLD certification;  
- verify their specific requirements and agree the methods of carrying out the tests indicated in this Call in conformity with Italian Law 170/2010 and the respective MIUR Guidelines.

**ART. 7 - Criteria for formulation of the rankings**

The rankings are drawn up exclusively according to:

- the score obtained in the test;
- the preferences expressed by all participants, until all available places have been filled.

In the event of a tie (equal scores), the scores obtained by the applicant in the following areas give them precedence: in order of decreasing importance, General Cultural Knowledge, Logical Reasoning, History, Drawing and Representation, Physics and Mathematics.

Should the tie persist, the applicant who is younger (by date of birth) will take precedence.

**Applicants who have not answered any questions will not be included in the rankings.**

Your ability to **enrol** at the Politecnico di Milano is subject exclusively to **these rankings**.

If your position in one of the rankings allows you to enrol, you may proceed to enrolment.

The first ranking will be posted on **2 August 2021**.

As per art. 9 of this Call for Applications, the following rankings will be posted:

- two subsequent rankings reserved for EU and equivalent students;
- one subsequent ranking reserved for non-EU students.

**ART. 8 - Knowledge of the English language**

The Politecnico di Milano requires students enrolled in these programmes to have a knowledge of the English language in addition to passing the test referred to in articles 4 and 5.

The level required is different for students registered for courses taught in Italian or English.

After having taken the CISIA admission test, all applicants will be required to remotely complete an English language test, which consists of 30 multiple-choice questions and which will last for 15 minutes.

In order to demonstrate an adequate level of knowledge of the English language, applicants enrolling in a course taught in Italian will have to respond to at least 24 questions correctly: failure to achieve this minimum will result in being given Additional Educational Obligations (OFA) for English.

Please note that **this test is only suitable for certifying a student's knowledge of English for the purposes of courses delivered in Italian** and does not contribute to the calculation of the score for the purposes of rankings.

Applicants enrolling in Italian-language courses must demonstrate a knowledge of English at a higher level, exclusively by way of one of the methods indicated at [www.polimi.it](http://www.polimi.it) > “Info per: Studenti iscritti > lingua inglese” [“Info for: Students enrolled > English language”].

Applicants enrolling in English-language courses must demonstrate a knowledge of English at a higher level, exclusively by way of one of the methods indicated at [www.polimi.it](http://www.polimi.it) > “Info per: Studenti iscritti > lingua inglese” [“Info for: Students enrolled > English language”].

For all applicants, enrolment without demonstration of knowledge of the English language will involve them being given OFA (Additional Educational Obligations) for English, resulting in the following restrictions in the formulation of their study plan:

- students will not be allowed to take on extra taught courses;
- students will not be allowed to take on taught courses from years subsequent to their enrolment year early;
- students will not be allowed to formulate an independent study plan;
