**Massimo Bricocoli** is Full Professor at the Department of Architecture and Urban Studies at Politecnico di Milano, where he is Faculty Member of the School of Architecture, Planning and Construction Engineering and teaches Housing and Neighbourhoods and Urban Ethnography.

In 2015 he was appointed Full Professor (Chair of the city of Esch sur Alzette) at the Université du Luxembourg where he was based for two semesters; in 2014 he was Velux Visiting professor at the Centre for Urbanism at the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts; in 2009-2010 he was Alexander von Humboldt Research Fellow at Humboldt Universitaet zu Berlin and HafenCity University Hamburg.

Research outcomes are documented in a number of scientific publications consisting of books, book chapters and articles.
