The five-year project will be divided into clear and measurable actions on 5 well-defined and measurable phases (called Implementation Objectives, OR), which are:

OR1 – ELECTRONICS concerning sensors, components and electronic boards at the basis of the "acquisition and processing" hardware of the smart eyewear. New cameras and video cameras and new sensors will be integrated into the glasses frame, together with the electronics for acquisition, pre-processing, storage and transmission to the edge and then to the cloud for low latency Artificial Intelligence (AI) processing.

OR2 – PHOTONICS concerning optics and photonics for the projection and vision through the lens of images and contents for Augmented Reality (AR), to allow the eyewear not only to acquire images and signals from the surrounding world and from the metaverse but also to provide and display real-time information to the user. This result can be obtained using micro-optical/photonics systems capable of creating computer-generated holograms and integrating them with natural vision by means of innovative optical devices based on diffractive elements or meta-surfaces integrated into the lenses.

The right to use the beneficiary's materials, documents and information includes:
