HAVING REGARD TO Presidential Decree no. 445 dated 28/12/2000;

HAVING REGARD TO articles 2 and 12 of Prime Ministerial Decree of 9 April 2001, "Equal treatment in the right to university studies";

HAVING REGARD TO the Regulation for Administration, Finance and Accounting of the University issued with Rectoral Decree no. 828, prot. no. 7766 of 14/03/2014 and particularly art. 75 and 79;

HAVING REGARD TO the proposal of the Permanent Students' Committee regarding the establishment of scholarships for sports merits;

HAVING REGARD TO the reorganisation of the Merit Fund approved by the Board of Governors on 22/07/2014;

HAVING REGARD TO the resolution of the Board of Governors of 24/09/2024;

DECREES

The issuance of the Call for Applications for **30 scholarships for "Sports Merits" for a.y. 2024/2025**.

art. 1

Recipients and characteristics of the scholarships

The 30 scholarships, for a gross amount of € 5,000 each and inclusive of charges borne by the Politecnico di Milano, are addressed to students who, in a.y. 2024/2025 are enrolled in one of the following training courses at the Politecnico di Milano:

- Laurea (equivalent to a Bachelor of Science);
- Single-cycle Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to a Master of Science);
- Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to a Master of Science)

and who have practiced, at high levels, sports recognised either by the Italian National Olympic Committee (hereafter, CONI) or by the International Olympic Committee (hereafter, IOC).

**art. 2
Admission requirements**

Students enrolled in a.y. 2024/2025 must be duly¹ registered.

Students enrolled in academic years prior to a.y. 2024/2025 must have obtained and duly registered in their academic record, by the closing date of the Call for Applications, an average score and a minimum number of ECTSs counting towards obtaining their qualification as detailed below:

Students must have participated in competitions of the Sports Federations and Associated Disciplines recognised by CONI or by IOC in the timeframe between September 1st 2023 and September 30th 2024.

The sports and disciplines published in the ATTACHMENT N°2 are eligible.

In particular:

Individual sports

For **Individual Sport Disciplines**, participations in Absolute Championships and Absolute Youth Championships of specialties or in higher level international events are considered.

¹ In order to be considered duly registered the student must pay the first instalment of tuition fees, as well as the administrative fee by the deadline specifically established by the Student Affairs Unit.

Team sports

For **Team Sports Competitions**, participations in Federal Championships at the national level with the team are considered.

art. 3 **How to participate**

Students are required to submit their application form through the specific function of the Online Services **by 12:00 noon (Italian time) of January, 15th 2025**.

This is the path:

Online Services > Benefits and agreements > Economic Benefits > Bando di concorso per n. 30 borse di studio per Meriti Sportivi a.a. 2024/2025

Students should attach in pdf format of a maximum of 10 MB the certification of the federation which they belong to, which proves their participation in the sport competitions which they joined and the respective results achieved therein. The certification will need to state:

- The name of the competition;
- The date and location where the competition took place;
- The code of the result of interest, which can be found in Annex 1.

Files must be named as follows: Surname-First Name-Document Type.pdf (for example, Smith-John-CV.pdf).

The closure of the online application, which takes place by clicking “close and submit application”, signifies its submission and implies the acceptance of the content of the Call disciplining it.

It is the student’s responsibility to check that they have properly completed the procedure.

After having completed and submitted the application, the student may print a receipt and the application may no longer be edited. The student can delete the application and submit a fresh one before the deadline set out in this Call for Applications.

Failure to complete and submit the application or submitting an incomplete application will result in the student being excluded from the assessment.

**art. 4
Selection Committee**

Granting the scholarships is decided based on a ranking drawn up by a Selection Committee appointed by decree signed by the Director.

Initially, a preliminary ranking based on academic merit will be created; points will be awarded for merit ranging from 0 to 24 and will be granted based on the following criteria:

Given that students who had enrolled in the academic years precedent to 2024/2025 must own an overall grade of at least 24/30 in order to be eligible to participate in this Call, the assignation of the score for students enrolled in 2024/2025 will require a reshuffling of the entry test and graduation score in unity of 30. The minimal score of 3 will be assigned solely to those who will obtain a reparametrising equal to 24. To those inferior to 24, 0 points will be assigned.

The Judging Commission will conduct its evaluations based on the goals attained in the relevant sport, up to a maximum of 100 points, following the order of the preliminary ranking.

The diffusion index elaborated by CONI², which represents the percentage of athletes enrolled in light of the total number of federations, will also be taken into consideration.

When an athlete has numerous legitimate sporting performances, the one that yields the highest score is taken into consideration for ranking purposes.

In the event of a tie, priority will be given to those who did not win the scholarship for “Sports Merits a.y. 2023/2024”.

Should there still be a tie, the younger student will take precedence.

Should all or part of the students not be deemed eligible for participation, then all or part of the scholarships offered will not be awarded. In this case, the residual funds will be added to those for the following academic year.

art. 5

Payment of scholarship amounts

Scholarships are paid in a single instalment. After the publication of the ranking, all the winners of the scholarship will be notified via their institutional e-mail address.

Detailed instructions will be provided upon notification of assignment on how to finalise the acceptance of the scholarship.

The winners are invited to take part in the awards ceremony held at Politecnico di Milano.

art. 6

Combining scholarships - Revocation - Waiver

The scholarship cannot be combined with other scholarships or other forms of financial aid provided by Politecnico di Milano for the academic year relating to this Call for Applications.

Instead, the scholarship may be combined with the Diritto allo Studio scholarship and benefits, and with the international mobility contributions provided by the Politecnico or by other public or private entities. The scholarship may also be combined with exemptions from tuition fees and contributions.

The scholarship may be revoked if the beneficiary has incurred in disciplinary sanctions. Moreover, it will be revoked if the student withdraws from their studies or transfers to another university during the year.

In the event of the winner waiving the scholarship or failing to deliver the necessary forms on time, the scholarship will be awarded to the next eligible student in the ranking.

art. 7
Taxation

The amounts paid are subject to tax, under applicable scholarship legislation.

The amount paid as a scholarship is considered the equivalent of employment income, and as such is subject to the same taxation. The charges borne by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the applicable IRAP rate for that year.

art. 8
Validation of truthful statements

The Politecnico of Milan validates the truthfulness of statements given by the student based on the methods set forth by law, in particular art. 76 of Presidential Decree no. 445/2000.

In the case of untruthful statements, sanctions shall be applied pursuant to articles 75 and 76 of Presidential Decree no. 445/2000.

In any case, this is without prejudice to any disciplinary sanctions and criminal regulations that should apply, should the fact constitute a crime.

art. 9
Personal data processing

The processing of personal data is carried out in compliance with the provisions of EU Regulation of 27 April 2016, no. 679 (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR). The “Data Controller” is Politecnico di Milano.
