HAVING REGARD to last will and testament of Vittorio Nosedà where he declares the intention to donate to the Politecnico di Milano the sum of € 400.000,00 in order to provide a scholarship in memory of prof. Giorgio Nosedà for one or more graduating or graduated students in "Hydraulic Engineering";
HAVING REGARD to D.Dir. no. 3517 prot. no. 55397 issued on 21/06/2017, in which the donation is formally accepted;
HAVING REGARD to the availability of residual resources;

HEREBY DECREES

The issuance of competition notice for n. **3 scholarships "prof. Giorgio Nosedà "** **a.y. 2022/2023.**

art. 1

Recipients and scholarship features

The n. 3 scholarships, **each one** with gross amount of **€ 5,000**, per year for two years ,included expenses charged to Politecnico di Milano, are intended for **students of a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) Ingegneria Civile – Civil Engineering** programmes of Politecnico di Milano.

The scholarships will be provided for two academic years for a total value of €10,000 each one.

The scholarships will be confirmed and the amount allocated for the 2022/2023 academic year will be disbursed for the following academic year provided that the requirements set out in Art. 5 of this call are satisfied.

Requirements for participation

The competition is open to students of degree courses of Politecnico di Milano that meet the following conditions, by the end of this Notice:

1. will be enrolled for a.y. 2022/2023 in a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) Ingegneria Civile – Civil Engineering programmes;
2. Submission of Study Plan (PSPA) WAT - WATER ENGINEERING

The Fundraising and Alumni Unit will verify whether the requirements have been met using the Politecnico di Milano's digital archive.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the data present in the Politecnico di Milano's digital archive are correct and current by the deadline of this call for applications.

art. 3 **How to participate**

Candidates are required to submit the application form through the dedicated function available from On-line services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Benefits and agreements> Economic benefits) **within 12.00 noon (Italian time) of 31 March 2023.**

Upon completion of the online application process (status:closed), the application to this call shall be deemed to have been submitted and the applicant shall be understood to have agreed to the contents of the call itself.

It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the process has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. The applicant may delete and resubmit the application at any time before the deadline of this call for applications.

Failure to complete the application, the submission of an incomplete application or the submission of inadequate documents shall result in the applicant being excluded from the assessment process.

art. 4 **Granting of scholarship**

The scholarship will be awarded according to a ranking list compiled by the office of the Fundraising and Alumni Unit based on the information available in the Politecnico di Milano's digital archive.

The ranking list will be drawn up through the allocation of a score determined by the following formula:

WEIGHTED AVERAGE x REGISTERED CFU
(at the deadline of the call)

In case of further equal score, the younger candidate will come first.

Renewal of scholarships

The recipients of “prof. Giorgio Nosedà” scholarship for the a.y. 2022/2023 can obtain **the renewal of scholarship** for the next academic year if they meet the conditions below:

3. **Be registered in the a.y. 2023/2024** in a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) Ingegneria Civile – Civil Engineering programmes PSPA WAT - WATER ENGINEERING, within time schedule deadline of academic year

 - registration of at **least 35 CFU** regularly registered and useful for graduation within 30/09/2023

The above requirements will be verified by the office of the Fundraising and Alumni Unit, enabling the automatic renewal of the scholarship.

art. 6

General Rules

Combinations: the scholarship cannot be combined with others or other forms of financial aid provided by Politecnico for the same academic year of reference of this call for applications. **The scholarship may be combined with the Diritto allo Studio scholarship and benefits**, and international mobility contributions provided by Politecnico or other public or private entities. The scholarship may also be combined with exemptions from tuition fees and contributions.

Revocation: the scholarship may be revoked if disciplinary sanctions are brought against the beneficiary. It will be revoked if the beneficiary withdraws from their studies or transfers to another university during the year.

Waiver: if the winner waives or fails to return the necessary forms, the prize will be awarded to the next highest applicant in the ranking.

Allocation: the scholarship assignment will be notified to the winner at their official University e-mail address. The winner must return the relevant forms attached to the award notification, signed for acceptance within 10 days of receiving the notice.

The scholarship will be paid in a lump sum by Politecnico di Milano.

If the scholarship is not paid the remaining funds will be used to establish a new call.

Self-certification: the Politecnico di Milano will verify the recipient's declarations and any false declarations will result in the forfeiture of any benefits awarded.

Taxation: payments awarded are subject to taxation, under applicable scholarship rules. The scholarship award is treated as employment income, and is subject to the same taxation. The costs borne by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the scholarship amount.

PRIVACY POLICY UNDER ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

Politecnico di Milano (henceforth **Politecnico**), in the role of the Data Controller, with offices at Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Management -, informs you about the methods for processing your personal data, in compliance with EU Regulation 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of personal data and its implementation regulations (henceforth the **Regulation**).

The Controller of processing of the data you have provided is the Head of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data regarding you collected and processed by the Politecnico are **(a)** the data provided by you upon registration or enrolment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; **(b)** data collected upon submission of your application, in particular, data related to your academic career, the degree programme you have completed, and your financial status data.

B. PROCESSING METHODS AND PURPOSES

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes:

1. for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the procedure according to the criteria set forth in this call for applications and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

In relation to the aforesaid purposes, the data will be processed by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to what is necessary with respect to the purposes for which the data are processed, and in any case in such a way as to guarantee the utmost security and confidentiality and always in full compliance with current legislation.

C. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY NATURE OF THE DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes set forth in section B point 1 is mandatory; any refusal to provide them will result in the inadmissibility of the application and immediate exclusion from the process.

D. SCOPE OF CIRCULATION AND COMMUNICATION OF DATA

Your personal data will be communicated to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process those data, namely natural or legal persons who work with Politecnico to implement the procedures for the selection and assignment of the award under this call. **Your data will also be communicated to the donor to inform it of the outcome of the call.**

If any contact is made by the donor, **the latter will be understood to be a separate and autonomous controller** of data processing. Therefore, the donor will provide you with an appropriate privacy policy.

E. STORAGE AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data will be stored at Politecnico di Milano and will not be transferred to a third country.

F. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

If the data are stored for longer periods, Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, point 1 of the Regulation.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to:
obtain information on the methods by which your data is processed and any other information under Art. 15 of the Regulation (*access right*)
rectify any of your personal data that are erroneous under Art. 16 of the Regulation (*rectification right*)
restrict the processing of your personal data under Art. 18 of the Regulation (*right to limit processing*);
object to the processing of your personal data in the cases and by the methods under Art. 21 of the Regulation (*right to object*)
