HAVING REGARD to Managerial Decrees with which it was declared that the donations were accepted;

HAVING REGARD to the residual funds of €40,00

The issuance of the call for no. 1 scholarships entitled “**Mr Alfredo Sala, Engineer**” a.y. **2026/2027**.

Art. 1
Introduction

The Scholarship is named after Alfredo Sala, an engineer who passed away prematurely in 2023, and they aim to support one worthy student undertaking the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) course in Mechanical Engineering at Politecnico di Milano.

Alfredo graduated in Mechanical Engineering with top marks in the 1984/85 academic year and undertook a successful managerial career which saw him occupy for many years the role of MD of ABB Italia.

His friends and fellow students want to remember him with a project that reflects his generosity and his sense of merit with the third edition of the initiative.

Art. 2
Scholarship features and recipients

The no. **1** scholarship, in the gross amount of **€6,000.00**, including costs borne by Politecnico di Milano, are intended for student enrolled in the **2025/2026 a.y. in the 1st year of the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) degree course in Mechanical Engineering at Politecnico di Milano.**

Art. 3
Participation requirements

Students possessing the following requirements by the call deadline may apply:

1. **enrolment for the first time in the 2025/2026 a.y.** on the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) degree course in Mechanical Engineering at Politecnico di Milano
2. **registration in the 2025/2026 a.y.** on the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) degree course in Mechanical Engineering at Politecnico di Milano
3. **at least 14 ECTS** useful for duly obtaining the qualification and earned during the student's career (including validations)
4. **weighted average** of examinations useful for obtaining the qualification and earned during the student's career of not less than **27/30**

5. **ISEE (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator)** (equivalent ISEEU for those not earning income in Italy) for 2025 no higher than **€51,000.00**
6. Residents in **Italy** in all **Regions**

The **2026** valid and compliant ISEE (Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator) (equivalent ISEEU for those not earning income in Italy), recorded in the University's database by the call deadline, will be considered.

In the absence of any valid and compliant 2026 ISEE/ISEEU certification, the student will be attributed, for the sole purposes of this call, the highest ISEE/ISEEU economic value (€95,001) thus leading to the absence of the requirement of Art. 3, point 5.

The Fundraising and Alumni Unit will ascertain possession of the requirements present in the computerised archive of Politecnico di Milano.

The candidate is responsible for verifying, by the call deadline, that the data present in the computerised archive of Politecnico di Milano are correct and up to date.

Art. 4 **Participation procedures**

Candidates must submit the application by way of the specific function available from the online services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Agevolazioni e Convenzioni > Borse di studio, premi di laurea, esoneri, bandi generici [Subsidies and Conventions > Scholarships, degree prizes, exonerations, generic notices]) **by 12pm (Italian time) on 27 March 2026**.

Completion of the online application (status: closed) is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call, and implies acceptance of its contents.

It is the candidate's responsibility to check that the procedure has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application, the candidate may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. The candidate may delete the application and submit a new one before the deadline set out in this call.

Failure to complete and submit the application, submitting an incomplete application or submitting inadequate documents will result in the candidate being excluded from the assessment procedure.

Art. 5
Scholarship assignment

The Fundraising and Alumni Unit will decide upon the assignment of the scholarship based upon what is recorded in the computerised archive of Politecnico di Milano.

The ranking will be put together based upon the score determined by the formula:

WEIGHTED AVERAGE x REGISTERED ECTS CREDITS
(at the call deadline)

The final assignment of the scholarship will occur following the verification of:

1. **enrolment in the second year of the 2026/2027 a.y. on the Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science) degree course in Mechanical Engineering at Politecnico di Milano by the deadlines scheduled by the academic calendar.**

If the candidates are still on an equal footing, priority will be given to the youngest candidate.

The available scholarship may not all be assigned if the candidates are found to be unsuitable.

The winners may be invited to a get-to-know-you meeting with the donors and to other events related to the scholarship.

Art. 6

General rules

Cumulation: the scholarships and any renewals thereof may not be combined with other scholarships or other forms of economic assistance provided by Politecnico, particularly with the benefits of the Diritto allo Studio Universitario (DSU) programme, for the same academic year of reference. The scholarships and any renewals thereof may, on the other hand, be combined with contributions for international mobility provided by Politecnico or by other public or private entities. The scholarship and any renewals thereof may also be combined with exemptions from university fees and contributions.

Disbursement: the assignment of the scholarship and any renewals thereof will be notified to the winner at their University institutional email address.

The winner must return the relevant forms attached to the award and renewal notification, signed for acceptance within 10 days of receiving the notice.

The scholarship will be paid in a lump sum by Politecnico di Milano.

If the scholarship is not paid or if the recipient fails to renew it, the remaining funds will be used to establish a new call.

Waiver: if the scholarship is waived or the winner fails to deliver the forms, the assignment will be transferred to the next suitable candidate in the ranking.

Revocation: the scholarship may be revoked if disciplinary sanctions are applied against the beneficiary. It will be revoked if the beneficiary withdraws from their studies or transfers to another university during the year.

If the scholarship is revoked, the beneficiary must return what has been paid to Politecnico di Milano and the amount will be used to establish a new call.

Self-certification: any ascertainment by Politecnico di Milano of false declarations leads to the forfeiture of any benefits received.

Taxation: payments awarded are subject to taxation, under applicable scholarship rules. The scholarship payment is treated as employment income, and is subject to the same taxation. The costs borne by Politecnico di Milano correspond to the IRAP rate of 8.5% of the scholarship amount.

PRIVACY POLICY UNDER ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION (GDPR)

Politecnico di Milano (henceforth also ***Politecnico***), in the role of the Data Controller, with offices at Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan – General Directorate, hereby informs you about the methods for processing your personal data, in compliance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and related implementing regulations (henceforth the ***Regulation***).

The Controller of processing of the data you have provided is the Director of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data regarding you collected and processed by the Politecnico are **(a)** the data provided by you upon registration or enrolment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, tax code, nationality, residential address, telephone and email contact details, educational qualifications; **(b)** data collected upon submission of your application, particularly data related to your academic career and your financial status.

B. PROCESSING METHODS AND PURPOSES

Your personal data may be processed for the following purposes: for the public interest of verifying requirements for participation in the procedure according to the criteria set forth in this call and all other legal purposes, including statistical.

In relation to the purposes indicated above, the data will be processed by Politecnico di Milano using manual, computerised and electronic tools, in a manner pertinent and limited to what is necessary for the purposes for which the data are processed, and to guarantee security and confidentiality in compliance with the applicable legislation.

C. MANDATORY OR VOLUNTARY DATA PROVISION

The provision of data for the purposes set forth in paragraph B point 1 is mandatory, and refusing to provide it will result in inadmissibility of the student's application and immediate exclusion from the process.

D. COMMUNICATION AND CIRCULATION OF DATA

Your personal data will be communicated to Politecnico employees who are authorised to process those data, namely natural or legal persons who work with Politecnico to implement the procedures for the selection and assignment of the award under this call.

Your data will be communicated to the donor to inform them of the call outcome.

If any contact is made by the donor, **the latter will be understood to be a separate and autonomous data controller**. The donor will provide you with an appropriate privacy policy.

E. STORAGE AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your data will be stored at Politecnico di Milano and will not be transferred to a third country.

F. DATA STORAGE PERIOD

Your data will be stored for the time strictly necessary to meet the requirements set forth by this call, unless they need to be stored for a longer period in the public interest. If the data are stored for longer, Politecnico guarantees compliance with the data minimisation principle under Art. 89, point 1 of the Regulation.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to:

obtain information about the methods by which your data are processed and any other information under Art. 15 of the Regulation (*right of access*)

obtain the rectification of any of your data that are inaccurate pursuant to Art. 16 of the Regulation (*right to rectification*)

restrict the processing of your data pursuant to

Art. 18 of the Regulation (*right to restriction of processing*);

object to the processing of your data in the cases and by the methods envisaged by Art. 21 of the Regulation (*right to object*)
