HEREBY DECREES

The issue of the call for applications for no. **1 laurea magistrale degree prize "Noemi Basso" year 2026.**

Introduction

Noemi Basso, was a brilliant student at the Politecnico di Milano studying Construction Architecture and then an excellent Research Coordinator.

She continued her career in Japan with the prestigious position of lecturer at Waseda University in Tokyo, continuing to collaborate with the Politecnico di Milano on research topics close to her heart, such as the relationship between architecture and structure, structural reliability and seismic vulnerability.

Thanks to the initiative of Professor Elsa Garavaglia and Noemi's family, a call was launched for a degree award in her memory.

Degree prize information and recipients

The laurea magistrale degree prize, worth € 1,000.00 gross net of all associated charges borne by the Politecnico di Milano, shall be awarded to the best MS thesis submitted on the theme *'Il rapporto Architettura-Struttura nella progettazione del nuovo e nel recupero dell'esistente'* (*The architecture-structure relationship in the design of new and refurbishment of existing structures*).

The call is open to students who have graduated from Politecnico di Milano with a Laurea Magistrale (equivalent to Master of Science):

1. In:
 - Architettura e Disegno Urbano – Architecture and Urban Design
 - Architettura- Ambiente Costruito-Interni-Architecture-Built Environment-Interiors
 - Architettura - Architettura delle Costruzioni (Architecture - Building Architecture)
 - Architectural Design and History – Progettazione Architettonica e Storia
 - Sustainable Architecture and Landscape Design – Architettura Sostenibile e Progetto del Paesaggio
 - Ingegneria Edile-Architettura (ciclo unico quinquennale)
2. During the period from January 2025 to December 2025
3. With a MS degree score no lower than 107/110

Strategic Research Agreements and Corporate Relations Unit will verify whether the requirements have been met using Politecnico di Milano's digital archive.

It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that the data present in Politecnico di Milano's digital archive are correct and current by the deadline of this call for applications.

art. 3

Application procedure

Applicants must submit an application using the relevant function available within Online Services <http://www.polimi.it/servizionline> (Agevolazioni e Convenzioni > Borse di studio, premi di laurea, esoneri, bandi generici) **by 12.00 (noon Italian time) on 11 March 2026.**

Applicants must attach the following:

1. attach the abstract of the thesis in A4 format max. 1 portrait page in pdf format max. 5 MB;
2. provide the link to a folder in cloud storage that must contain:
a single PDF file with a maximum of 4 tables of the MS thesis of no more than 3.5 MB each, so as to allow easy online consultation, significant for the understanding of the project (e.g.: framework, system, plans-sections, structure-architecture relationship, etc.), not necessarily the tables produced for the discussion of the thesis and not in high definition, format of your choice.

The files must be named using the format Surname-Name-Type of document.pdf (for example Smith-John-Thesis.pdf)

The folder containing annexes useful for evaluation must be named with the applicant's surname and first name.

It is recommended to check that the link to the folder is actually usable by the Selection Board, that it has no expiry date or access limits and that it is not damaged.

Documents shall be uploaded to the cloud by the deadline of the above-mentioned call and shall not be altered, under penalty of exclusion from the evaluation.

The completion of the online application (status: closed) is equivalent to submitting an application for participation in this call for applications, and implies acceptance of its contents.

It is the applicant's responsibility to check that the process has been completed correctly.

After having completed and submitted the application, the applicant may print a receipt and the application may no longer be altered. Applicants may delete and resubmit the application at any time before the deadline of the call.

The following will result in exclusion from the evaluation procedure:

- failure to close the application and/or incomplete application;
- failure to comply with the theme of the call for entries (see Article 2);
- inadequacy of the documents submitted;
- submission of unreadable files;
- delivery of materials other than those requested (see Article 3).
- unusable link;
- documents uploaded or modified in the folder in cloud storage after the deadline.

In the case of theses with multiple authors, each co-author that intends to apply for the award shall submit an individual application. In this case, all authors must submit identical documentation, as requested in Art. 3.

By submitting their application, the winning applicant agrees that their thesis or part of it may be disseminated in accordance with copyright.

Should one or more of the co-authors not wish to participate, it shall be left to the applicant author to decide whether to contact them in the event of winning the award. also for the purposes of disseminating the contents of the thesis.

art. 4

Selection Committee

The awarding of the MS degree award is decided on the basis of a ranking drawn up by a Selection Board appointed by managerial decree after the deadline of the call for applications.

In formulating the ranking list, the Board shall only take into account the attachments uploaded via the official procedure and will only evaluate theses deemed relevant to the subject matter of the call for applications (see Article 2).

On the condition that the requirements in Art. 2 of the call are met, in the event that multiple applicants hold equivalent qualifications, the Board may decide to divide the amount of the award among them.

Should the Selection Board decide that none of the theses presented by the applicants is adequate, the award shall not be awarded.

art. 5 **General rules**

Cumulability: the laurea magistrale degree prize cannot be added to other prizes awarded for the same laurea magistrale degree thesis by Politecnico di Milano.

Renunciation: if the winner renounces the prize, it will be awarded to the next highest ranking applicant in the ranking list.

Award: the winner will be informed of the laurea magistrale degree prize award via an e-mail sent to his/her university e-mail address. No later than 10 days from receiving the e-mail, the winner must sign for acceptance and send the specific forms s/he will find attached to the award e-mail.

The Politecnico di Milano shall award the prize in a single instalment.

Self-certification: Politecnico di Milano will verify the recipient's declarations and any false declarations will result in the forfeiture of any benefits awarded.

Taxation: the prize awarded is subject to the current laws governing the taxation of scholarships. The sum paid as the degree prize is to be treated as income comparable to income from employment for taxation purposes. The tax due by the Politecnico di Milano is IRAP (equal to 8.5% of the value of the degree prize).

INFORMATION PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 13 OF THE EUROPEAN GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION

Through this document, the Politecnico di Milano (hereinafter also called *Polytechnic*), as Data Controller, with offices located in Piazza Leonardo da Vinci 32, 20133 Milan - General Management - , informs you with regard to the processing of your personal data, in compliance to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and Council dated 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals regarding the processing of personal data and related implementing legislation (hereinafter also called the *Regulations*).

The Data Processor, of the data provided by you, is the Director of the Research, Innovation and Corporate Relations Division.

A. PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The personal data collected and processed by the Polytechnic, which regards you, is the following: (a) the data you communicated at the time of registration or enrollment, such as name, surname, date and place of birth, sex, social security number, nationality, address of residence, telephone and IT addresses, qualifications; (b) the data collected at the time of submission of the application, in particular the data relating to your academic career, qualifications achieved, as well as the data to your financial condition.

B. PURPOSE AND METHOD OF PROCESSING

Your personal data may be processed:

E. RETENTION AND POSSIBLE TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA

Your personal data will be stored at the Politecnico di Milano. Your data will not be transferred to a third country.

F. PERSONAL DATA PERIOD OF RETENTION

Your personal data will be kept for the time strictly necessary to guarantee access to the right to study benefits, unless the retention of data for a longer period is necessary for archiving purposes in the public interest, for scientific or historical research or for statistical purposes. Should data retention be needed for longer periods, the Polytechnic guarantees compliance with the principle of data minimization pursuant to art. 89, paragraph 1 of the Regulations.

G. YOUR RIGHTS

We would like to remind you that you have the right:

- to obtain information in relation to the ways in which your data is processed and any other information required by art. 15 of the Regulations (*right of access*)



- to obtain the correction of inaccurate personal data concerning you pursuant to art. 16 of the Regulations (*rectification right*)
