

DEPOSITING IN OPEN ACCESS IN THE IRIS RE.PUBLIC REPOSITORY

The IRIS RE.PUBLIC Research Catalogue is the institutional archive of publications produced by the university's scientific community.

In accordance with Law 112 (7 October 2013), the European Commission Recommendation (17 July 2012), project call requirements and the University Open Access Policy (active since 1 October 2014), Politecnico di Milano authors must upload the full text of their publications to IRIS RE.PUBLIC.

Authors must indicate the access rights of the file (Open Access, Open Access with embargo, or Restricted Access) and accept the final deposit and preservation consent.

Full Text – What to Deposit

- For open access journals: upload the publisher PDF version of the publication.
- For non-open access journals with APC-funded open access: upload the publisher PDF version made available in open access.
- For non-open access journals: upload the publisher-permitted version with restricted access plus the Author's Accepted Manuscript (AAM) for open access deposit if allowed.
