CONSIDERED the participation of the Politecnico di Milano in the Erasmus+ Programme and in particular the existing Agreement n. 2024-1-IT02-KA131-HED-000227228;

CONSIDERED the program agreed upon between the parties for the realisation of a Blended Intensive Programme coordinated by the University of Valladolid;

ASCERTAINED the availability of financial resources;

HEREBY DECREES

the issuing of this call for the identification of PhD candidates which will take part in the Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) "Biological Biocarbon Capture Technologies".

Art. 1 - Addressees

This call is addressed to all active PhD candidates regularly enrolled at the Politecnico di Milano. Applicants must still be enrolled at the Politecnico di Milano at the time of the course. The applications of those who have already participated in previous editions of the course will not be taken into consideration.

Art. 2 - Description of the project

This call concerns the participation in the intensive scientific course "Biological Biocarbon Capture Technologies, which will take place to Valladolid from 13 to 17 July 2026.

At the end of the course, the winning PhD candidates will be awarded 5 ECTS credits for the activities carried out. The recognition of the credits in the career of the PhD candidates will follow the rules defined by the PhD School.

Art. 3 – Submission of application

To take part in the selection process it is necessary to fill in the sheet available in this on-line [link](#) by uploading the following documents in a single pdf file:

- Curriculum vitae;
- Motivation letter indicating the relevance of the research topic to the course content.

All applications must be sent, under penalty of inadmissibility, by 12:00 pm (Italian time) on 18 May 2026.

Art. 4 – Selection process

The Commission in charge of evaluating the applications is appointed by decree of the Head of the Teaching Service and will draw up a merit ranking based on the documentation attached to the application form. In the selection process, the Committee will award the following scores:

- up to 20 points for the curriculum vitae;
- up to 20 points for the motivation letter.

The merit ranking will be published starting from 22 May, 2026 and the selected candidates will receive a communication to the University e-mail address indicated in the application form.

For selected students, participation is mandatory. Where a student is unable to participate for exceptional reasons, he must give timely communication to Prof. Andrea Turolla at the following address: andrea.turolla@polimi.it.

Art. 5 – Remuneration

The first five PhD candidates in the ranking list will be awarded a mobility allowance of €79.00 per day for the five days of in-person activities. This allowance is compatible with the 50% increase of the PhD scholarship granted by Politecnico di Milano for the period spent abroad.

In addition to the above-mentioned mobility allowance, a lump-sum travel contribution of €309.00 will be granted. In the case of green travel (train, bus, bicycle, carpooling), the lump-sum travel contribution will amount to €417.00. In this case, most of the journey must be carried out using a green means of transport (train, bus, bicycle, carpooling).
