Established in 1914, the Estonian Academy of Arts is the only public university in Estonia providing higher education in fine arts, design, architecture, media, visual studies, art history, and conservation.

The Faculty of Architecture is the focal point of Estonian architectural education and the most important centre of competence in disciplines related to artificial environments, including interior architecture, architecture, landscape design, and urban planning. The nucleus of the course is comprised of the Architecture and Urban Design as well as Interior Architecture programmes. When studying architecture, it is also possible to study landscape architecture as a subsidiary subject. An important aspect of the tuition is the long-term association between spatial and material knowledge of all scales.

Regular and close contact is maintained with the world outside the academy through exhibition and publishing activities and the organising of various events, or in cooperation with businesses and public institutions.

EKA is striving to be among the leading international centres of innovation in the field of visual culture. In addition to active study and research activities, the Estonian Academy of Arts also offers lifelong learning opportunities through the Open Academy. The lecturers and instructors are professionals in their field — internationally recognised artists, architects, designers, historians, and scientists.
