The University of Cyprus, established in Nicosia in 1989 in response to the growing intellectual needs of the Cypriot people, fulfils the numerous aspirations of the country. Since 2005, the Department of Architecture and its vibrant community are located in the historical core of the town, in Ledra Street. A new campus with all the university facilities is placed in Aglantzia.

The Department of Architecture, part of the Faculty of Engineering and organized on a 4+1-year cycle, enrolls 40 freshmen per year forming professionals capable to connect local expertise with global knowledge. The Department is also a Centre for Mediterranean Architecture Research involving teachers with a background based on architectural digital design, environmental design, and innovative materials technologies to be applied in the millenary context of Cyprus aspiring to reach sustainability.

The Department of Architecture is in symbiosis with Cypriot society by interacting with studies and research in participatory planning of the territory and the built environment.

Points of strength

Nicosia is for the student that loves the challenges. The Cypriot Capital is just the starting point to discover the Venus' island, a place full of history, incredible landscapes and a pulsating social life that still manages to put together tradition with innovation.
