

FAQ FOREIGN LANGUAGE COURSES

When are language courses delivered?

Language courses are delivered every semester. The first semester, classes start in September and end in December whereas for the second semester, classes start in March and end in May.

The reference platform to register and find information is the *Language Courses catalogue* in the Online Services.

Will an official certificate be issued at the end of the language course?

Language courses do not prepare for official certifications tests.

They are basic/intermediate/advanced level courses aimed at improving language proficiency. At the end you may get a report of attendance (if you meet the 75% attendance requirement) that cannot be used as a certificate for your master's degree but can enrich your Curriculum Vitae.

Are remedial courses offered to remove OFA in English?

No, these are extracurricular courses aimed at improving English in a broad sense. The language proficiency requirements are related to the university career, consequently, when in doubt, one should contact the Student Secretary's Office.

If one applies to go on international mobility but does not yet know the assigned university, how does one choose the language course?

Outgoing students can register for a foreign language course by the deadline indicated in the language course catalogue according to their initial interest. When faced with the outcome of the call for international mobility, they can contact linguestraniere@polimi.it to possibly be moved, **subject to availability**, to the language course most useful for their international mobility.
