- **CIMEA Statement of Verification**
- **Online database provided by the issuing institution.** The institution must provide the database link and instructions for consultation (e.g., via a QR code or a clickable link indicated on the document).
- **confirmation e-mail** sent directly by the awarding Institution:
Official confirmation of graduation must be sent directly by the awarding institution's Registrar's Office to the following email address: international.mi@polimi.it.
The SUBJECT of the e-mail must indicate the student's Polimi PERSON CODE, First Name and Surname.
A copy of the graduation certificate must be attached to the email.
Please note: Confirmations sent by individual professors will not be accepted. Politecnico di Milano reserves the right to carry out further verification to ensure the authenticity of the documents.

The **deadline** to submit the CIMEA Statement of Verification, the online verification link, or for the receipt of the institutional confirmation email is **October 31st**.

For students requiring a visa for Italy, the University application will only be confirmed once the authenticity of the qualification has been verified.

CHINA

All the Chinese degrees can be verified online from the CSSD (China Credentials Verification) website: <https://www.chsi.com.cn/en/>.

Apart from the declaration of value, or CIMEA Statement of Comparability, students with a Chinese degree must upload the "Online Verification Report of Higher Education Degree Certificate", along with the actual degree.

INDIA

All the Indian degrees can be verified online with the e-Apostille. Apart from the declaration of value, or CIMEA Statement of Comparability, students with an Indian degree must upload their degree with the e-Apostille containing the QR code necessary for the verification.

IRAN

All the Iranian degrees can be verified online from the Saorg (Student Affairs Organization) website: <https://portal.saorg.ir/inquiry>. Apart from the declaration of value, or CIMEA Statement of Comparability, students with an Iranian degree must upload the documents related to the degree itself, containing the QR code necessary for the verification.

Students graduated from the Azad University may either apply for the CIMEA Statement of Verification or request a verification of authenticity from the Uni-Italia Centre in Iran. The office can be contacted at the following e-mail address: iran@uni-italia.it.

Due to the frequent instability of the Saorg (Student Affairs Organization) website, students graduated from all Iranian universities, at any time may be asked to either submit their degree accompanied by the CIMEA Statement of Verification or to obtain the verification of authenticity from the Uni-Italia Centre in Iran.

RUSSIAN FEDERATION

Unfortunately, the e-Apostille on Russian documents cannot be verified with the internet providers currently in use. Also, the government database [FRDO](#) is currently not accessible from Italy.

For these reasons, unless a digital verification method is offered by the institution issuing the degree, this must be accompanied by CIMEA Statement of Verification.

TURKEY

Unless a degree can be verified online on the higher institution of graduation's website, the students must ask the university to issue the degree on the Government website <https://www.turkiye.gov.tr/belge-dogrulama>. It is therefore necessary to upload a copy of the title containing the barcode number or QR code for the online verification.

PAKISTAN

All the Pakistani degrees can be verified online from the Higher Education Commission (HEC) [website](#). Apart from the declaration of value or CIMEA Statement of Comparability, students must upload both their degree with the HEC stamp affixed to it, as well as their passport (this must be uploaded in "My Data" section of the OnLine Services).
