POLIMI European Patent Litigation Certificate 2026 Edition

18th November 2025 – 21st May 2026

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The POLIMI European Patent Litigation Certificate, is a course, accredited by the UPC Administrative Committee, according to R. 6 of Draft EPLC and aimed at qualifying participants, after a final exam, as UPC representatives. (Decision D-AC/07/19072024_E 19 July 2024 of the Administrative Committee)

COURSE PARTICIPANTS

Only European Patent Attorneys entitled to act as professional representatives before the European Patent Office pursuant to Article 134 of the European Patent Convention are admitted to the course.

TRAINING FORMAT AND DISTANCE LEARNING

The course comprises 120 hours, divided in modules of three hours each, with classes once a week in the morning and in the afternoon, for a total of 20 days, of which 17 of theoretical lessons and 3 of practical training.

Lectures will be in English.

Lecturers have been selected for their competence and their teaching skills.

The presence in person is encouraged, but it is mandatory only for the three days of practical training.

Apart form the practical training, the participation to lessons will also be possible via internet.

All the participants will have access to video-recordings of the lectures, the presentations and the material of the course, which will be downloadable from the website with a personal password.

EXAM

The final exam will be organized the day after the end of the practical training, and it will comprise: Part a) Written – 30 multiple choice questions, Part b) Written – a legal case to be solved and Part c) an oral exam starting with the discussion of the legal case.

PATENT LITIGATION CERTIFICATE

The course will provide, those who will successfully pass the exam, with a European Patent Litigation Certificate according to R. 1 of the Draft EPLC.

According to Art. 13 of the Draft EPLC, the European Patent Attorney wishing to represent parties before the Unified Patent Court and be inserted in the list of UPC representatives, under Article 48(3) of the Agreement on a Unified Patent Court, shall lodge the Certificate with the Registrar.

PROGRAM

The course will have a legal focus, giving an insight into the Unitary Patent and the Unified Patent Court, as well into the patent litigation systems of several European countries.
